

RCC Covid 19 Health & Safety Policy

Health Precautions/Contact tracing

All Participants/Staff/Spectators must accept responsibility for their own health and wellbeing.

Any person displaying any symptoms of illness or having been exposed to any other person displaying such symptoms must not attend any RCC event.

If symptoms are identified after an RCC event the person must notify RCC as soon as possible and provide details of the illness.

RCC will appoint a Health & Safety officer who will oversee operations and ensure that required standards are met.

Personal Behaviour at events:

All people attending events must maintain a reasonable distance from others, must avoid coughing, sneezing or spitting in close proximity to any other people .

Riders should bring their own plastic bag to store clothing or equipment that will not be used during the race.

Minimize close contact

Registration:

A QR code will be displayed at all RCC events.

All members will be encouraged to enter online and pay either by direct deposit or with a race pass.

Online entry information will include names, phone numbers and email addresses: information will be stored for contact tracing purposes. Manual entry forms will gather the same information and will also be retained.

Spectators and supporters who enter the venue must register, or remain in their cars.

Riders will be reminded to bring their race number and timing tag with them so that they do not need to linger at the registration desk. Queues will be established with appropriate spacing between people.

Registration staff will wear masks, hand sanitizer will be available.

Race briefings will be held outdoors in areas where there is sufficient space for people to be widely spaced. A PA system will be used so that all people can clearly hear.

If more than 100 people attend, registration will be split into two separate locations.

Post-Race:

RCC encourages competitors to return home as soon as they have finished racing.

If more than 100 people attend an event or when the venue is not suitable, refreshments will not be served.

When appropriate hot drinks and biscuits will be available; queues will be established as for registration; riders will move away from the hospitality area as soon as they have their refreshments and will not congregate together.

All refreshment staff will wear masks, hand sanitizer will be available.
